Church Council Meeting Minutes for Thursday, September 19th^h, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Sara Schubert McKone at 6:04pm. Present were Don Anderson, Aine Merrill, Margaret Sundet, Pastor Sarah Gunderson, Donna Meltz, Shannon Johnson, Grace Becken (virtually) and Sara Schubert McKone.

Devotions were given by Aine. Next month will be Sara.

A motion was made by Donna and seconded by Shannon to accept August's secretary report. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Aine passed out current balances for all accounts. All youth gathering bills have been paid. Congregation has been made aware of the position of our finances. We encourage people to continue to give what they are able to. The council will keep the congregation up-to-date via the weekly e-newsletter. We will see if Lynn can make another reminder during the next service. Thank you to everyone for the gifts but we are still in need of help. Pastors Report: "God's Work. Our Hands." Sunday was held on Sunday, September 8th. We made sandwiches for our food cupboard and a group put together welcome baskets that can be taken to people who need a visit. We also blessed students and teachers in worship for the start of school. Superior Churches/Shared Ministry - United Campus Ministry starts this Sunday September 22nd with a welcome BBQ at 5:30 hosted at Pilgrim Lutheran Church. There will be a rotation for the churches involved to provide dinner. I am planning to be a part of the worship/bible study team along with the other pastors in Superior. Dates for Zion to provide meals: September 29, Oct 27 and Nov 17. There is a sign-up to build a team for each of those weeks. Book Study coming up: With Open Hands by Henri Nouwen will be our book this fall. The book invites us to reflect on prayer in short, reflective readings. Small group discussion will begin on Sept 24 and continue on Oct 8, 15, 22, 29. Tuesdays at 10am at church and 7pm on Zoom. Blessing of the Animals Mask Project: Paul Robinson is sharing his puppetry skills to lead us in the creation of animal masks to be used in worship on Oct 20th when we will bless the pets and remember the gift of God's creation. Paul will be inviting all ages to participate in a puppet workshop beginning on September 29 that will meet also on Oct 6 and 13 during the education hour at 9am. Candy Bar Sales continue this fall: The youth have some candy bars left, and the plan is to finish up selling the rest of them by the end of October using the profits to build up the account for the next youth trip. Fall Theological Retreat: I will be attending this synod event in Trego from Sunday evening Sept 29 to Tuesday afternoon, Oct 1st. Discipleship: Sunday school starts this Sunday. Logos started yesterday and small group is to start. Couple people showed up to the Wed night worship. Sara recommends that we make a Facebook event to get out the word on the Wednesday night service and meal afterwards. Bible study will start this Sunday and Book Club will start on Tuesday Worship and Music: 3rd Sunday was very popular. Made a plan to have a balance and blend of praise and traditional music in services. A lot of positive feedback so far.

Property: According to the city we are not able to use the balance of the grant money. It was all put back into the fund for other non-profit organizations to use. We are figuring out the snow plow contract. Should check into an ADA grant for the front door. Does Thrivent have any grants? Not sure but worth checking into. Need to look at other funding opportunities.

Stewardship:

WELCA: Just had their first meeting. Operations for the funeral went well. Had a lot of helpers, was a lot of work but went well.

Grace makes motion to accept all reports, Don seconds. Motion carries.
